Chalda Maloff



When Chalda Maloff earned a bachelor's degree in art history and a graduate degree in computer science in the 1970s, she was told neither would ever make her a living.

Decades later, after creative forays in oils, acrylics, aquatint and clay, Maloff has brought together her two passions of art and technology. She creates digital art that has been exhibited throughout the U.S., South America and Europe.

What began with a private demo of some of the earliest art software more than 40 years ago has become a unique body of work created from talent and technology. Recent awards for Maloff's work include the Guerilla Painter Award from the Visual Arts Society of Texas and second mention of honor at the VIII Salón de Arte Digital in Venezuela.
